Right of Access to Data (art. 15)	You may request access to the following information: a) purpose of data processing; b) categories of personal data in question; c) recipients or categories of recipients to whom your personal data have been or will be disclosed, in particular in the case of third-country recipients or international organisations; d) where possible, the period for which the personal data will be stored, or if that is not possible, the criteria used to determine that period; e) the existence of the right to request from the controller access to and editing or deleting of personal data or restriction of processing rights concerning the data subject and to object to data processing; f) the right to file a complaint with a supervisory authority; g) if the data were not collected from the data subject, all available information on data origin; h) the existence of an automated decision-making process, including profiling, pursuant to art. 22, paragraphs 1 and 4, and, at least in such cases, significant information on the logic used, as well as on the importance and expected consequences of such processing for the data subject. Right to Rectification (art. 16)	You have the right to request the correction of any of your personal data that may be inaccurate and to obtain the integration of incomplete personal data.	Information by writing to the addresses indicated above
Right to Erasure (art. 17)	You have the right to obtain from the Data Controller the deletion of any of your personal data if such personal data are no longer required for the purposes for which they were collected or otherwise processed, if you withdraw your consent, if there is no prevailing legitimate reason to proceed with the processing, if the data have been unlawfully processed, or if there is a legal obligation to delete them. Right to Restriction of processing (art. 18)	You have the right to obtain from the Data Controller a restriction of data processing rights if the accuracy of your personal data has been objected to (for the time necessary for the Data Controller to verify the accuracy of such personal data) or if processing is unlawful, but you object to the deletion of personal data and instead ask that their use be restricted, or if such data are necessary for the determination, exercise or defence of a right in court, while at the same time such data are no longer necessary for the Data Controller. Right to Portability (art. 20)	You have the right to receive personal data concerning you and submitted to us in a structured format, commonly used and readable by an automatic device and you have the right to forward such data to another Data Controller if processing is based on consent or on a contract or if processing is carried out by automated means, unless processing is necessary for the execution of a task of public interest or in connection to the exercise of public authority and providing such forwarding does not affect the rights of a third party.
